# **MESSAGE FROM THE BISHOP-PASTOR**

Secondly, there is that deep sense of belonginess of being owned by God. That we are not orphans in this life, left to fend for ourselves and to sink or swim on our own.

What makes the Christian life so interesting is that we are never sure what God would be doing in our lives round the corner. It need not be a kind of fearful anticipation like being up in a rollercoaster and not knowing now deep is the next dive. To overcome that fear of the unknown we need embrace two central truths.

Firstly, that God is a good God and His goodness includes kindness and patience. No matter how deep or shallow is the next dive in the rollercoaster of life, God deals with us with kindness in that he knows our limits; with patience in that he understands and accepts how long it takes for us to learn and we know how dense we can be at times. BE READY TO BE SURPRISED BY GOD BECAUSE HIS WISDOM AND LOVE IS MORE THAN ANY OF US CAN COMPREHEND. Secondly, there is that deep sense of belonginess of being owned by God. That we are not orphans in this life, left to fend for ourselves and to sink or swim on our own. We belong, we are the apple in God's eye in Christ. It gives us a sense of purpose though we may not be able to comprehend the full reasons for what we are going through. But we know, that whatever we are going through, will never be a 'waste of time' or meaningless.

2022 lies before us and I know that our loving God will do a new thing in our lives and with our lives. Things that were once common and mundane to us may turn out to be most extraordinary. Be ready to be surprised by God because His wisdom and love is more than any of us can comprehend.

Let's welcome this new year before us with a heart of thanksgiving and fortitude. For the LORD who gave His only Son for us on Calvary shall surely love us and shadow us in the days ahead.

May the Providence of God, the Love of Christ and the Transforming work of the Holy Spirit be each of you. Amen.
