And When You Pray. THE FIRST FORMAL LESSON on prayer I remember receiving was in Ms. Vicki's fourth-grade Sunday school class. Ms. Vicki took us fourth graders seriously even though we were children. "There's a difference between acting like children and acting childish," she reminded us. "I encourage the first," she continued, "but I don't tolerate the second."

Seated at the Sunday school table, Ms. Vicki taught us the correct format for prayer: A prayer should always include thanks, intercession, petition, and gratitude. And always, always in Jesus' name. That's where the power came from, she said. That phrase acted like a notary public; it made our prayer official and sent it straight to God. God was not a vending machine. Ms. Vicki insisted, but prayer did have a protocol. Prayer was a particular thing that one did or did not do, and the way we did it was important. – Hannah E. Shanks, This Is My Body. 
