



Human withdrawal [for meditation] is a very painful and lonely process, because it forces us to directly face our own condition in all its misery as well as its beauty. But when we are not afraid to enter into our own center and to concentrate on the stirrings of our own souls, we come to know that being alive means being loved. This experience tells us that we can only love because we are born out of love, that we can only give because our life is a gift, and that we can only make others free because we are set free by the One whose heart is greater than ours.

And when we have found the anchor places for our lives in our own center we can be free to let others enter into the space created for them, and allow them to dance their own dance, sing their own song, and speak their own language without fear. Then our presence is no longer threatening and demanding, but inviting and liberating.

Saya telah dilahirkan dalam sebuah keluarga Kristian, telah dibaptis ketika berumur 1 bulan. Saya anak ketiga dari empat adik-beradik. Ibu bapa telah mendidik serta telah mengajar saya untuk mengenal Tuhan, mereka memberikan pengajaran kekeristinan kepada saya seawal sekolah minggu. Oleh itu, saya sangat seronok dan gembira ketika dapat datang ke gereja dan mendengar cerita Alkitab yang disampaikan oleh guru-guru sekolah minggu pada masa itu. Salah satu aktiviti geraja yang saya gemari adalah "Sunday School Kem" saya masih ingat peristiwa yang telah terjadi masa itu.

Ketika saya berumur 13 tahun, pertama kalinya saya mengikuti Pelayanan Belia (Youth Ministry). Mereka sentiasa memberikan peluang untuk saya melayani Tuhan. Ada banyak pelayanan yang mereka sediakan dan pada masa itulah saya dedahkan tentang hal pelayanan. Saya juga telah diberikan peluang untuk memimpin ibadah minggu, aktiviti belia dan juga pelayanan sekolah minggu.

Nah, disinilah permulaan saya untuk ingin belajar Firman Tuhan, agar saya dapat membantu mereka yang belum memahami tentang perkara ini.

Tuhan membuka peluang tepat pada waktunya, setelah selesai menduduki peperiksaan SPM, saya katakan kepada mama (mother) saya bahawa saya mempunyai keinginan untuk belajar Alkitab, sementara pada masa itu saya sedang menunggu keputusan SPM keluar. Lalu mama saya memberikan keizinan dengan hanya memberikan masa 3 bulan (Program 3 bulan). Kerana ibu bapa saya ada ketentuan yang lain untuk saya. Saya telah memasuki sekolah Alkitab iaitu Pusat Pendidikan Theology (PPT) atau sekarang lebih dikenali sebagai *Luther Seminary* (LS).

Saya masih berfikir bahawa memasuki Seminari pada masa itu adalah atas keinginan atau kehendak diri sendiri. Namun, ketika saya sudah memulakan kehidupan saya sebagai seorang mahasiswa saya merasakan bahawa Tuhan sendiri yang telah memilih dan memanggil saya, kerana ada satu perasaan yang lain, iaitu beban berat yang harus dilaksakan. ketika melihat pelayanan dalam pandangan yang lebih luas, saya adalah antara yang terpanggil secara peribadi untuk menyerahkan kehidupan saya yang masih mud aini kepada Tuhan.

Saya berfikir 3 bulan tidak cukup untuk saya, kerana ada banyak perkara yang ingin saya belajar lagi, dengan penuh keberanian saya berbincang dengan keluarga saya, bahawa saya ingin memilih untuk menjadi seorang pelayan Tuhan. Saya bersyukur kerana mereka memahami keinginan saya, tidak ada orang yang mamaksa saya memilih jalan ini. saya menginspraskan seorang Pendeta Wanita yang pada masa itu juga merupakan Guru saya.

Setelah 2 tahun belajar di Seminari, ada banyak perkara mengubah kehidupan saya dimana saya menjadi seorang saya lebih berfikiran matang, mempunyai Visi dan mimpi dalam hidup serta lebih matang dalam hal kerohanian. Perkara-perkara ini telah perubahan yang sangat ketara dalam kehidupan saya.

Pengatahuan saya yang ada masih belum cukup mungkin dimasa hadapan saya akan berhadapan dengan pelbagai individu dan kolompok yang mempunyai keinginan untuk belajar akan Firman Tuhan, maka saya boleh membantu mereka. Sebab itu alasan utama saya untuk belajar di STM, Puji Tuhan, mereka telah melangkapi saya.

Melanie is a lifelong cat stalker. Hailing from Klang, she also spent 5 years studying and working in Penang. She's currently working for Malaysian CARE in Church Relations and Advocacy.

MELANIE

What inspired you to take up Theological Studies & pursue full-time ministries?"

Growing up in church I often sang this song, "Here I am Lord, send me" and heard multiple sermons preached on loving the poor. But when I started working at a human rights NGO, I saw how few Christians was involved in advocating for justice. I began to realise a disconnect between instruction and action. Even though the need was so great, I barely met any Christian colleagues or volunteers. Many were content to donate or pray by the side lines. This was what led me to study theology in Boston in 2016 and thankfully God provided with a scholarship. Being in the midst of several great universities, I had the opportunity to study in a Jesuit run school amongst different Catholic orders some of whom I was exposed to for the first time. I also studied about women in the Quran and Jewish scriptures at HDS (*Harvard Divinity School*) under visiting scholars. It was an intellectually stimulating place to be!

But more importantly it was a conducive place to learn about justice, and where terms like *postcolonial*, *feminist* and *liberation theology* gave me a language to describe the dissonance I felt.

A compulsory reading, "*Letter from a Birmingham Jail*", by Martin Luther King Jr became one of my favourite sermons. Exposure to writings from every corner of the world written from the perspective of non Westerners, women, the disabled and those who have been marginalized have caused me to be more critical of the books and scholarship that many Malaysians (myself included) have consumed in the past and I hope to highlight these voices in the work that I do.



"I like joining the Bible Study to learn how God's people have journeyed through time with Him, know Him better and apply the lessons in my walk and journey with Him".



Tuesday Bible Study meets weekly at 8.30 pm. Contact Janelle for more information.
